

Draft Protocol for 6/22/2020 Board meeting :

Preliminary protocol based on the 6/17/2020 amendments to Routt County health regulations:

Steamboat Art Museum - Re-opening protocol

- SAM will operate under the rules of a business.
- Routt County Re-opens Poster is posted upon entering.
- Mitigation Protocol – Appendix A (4 pages) will be completed and available at entry. This no longer is required to be filed with the County.
- All employees will wear masks when visitors are in the exhibition hall.
- Employee daily health self- check log will be maintained at reception desk.
- Inside the front door on a stand:
 - Masks required sign, plus paper masks if forgotten
 - Hand Sanitizer
 - Sign to please view Exhibit in counterclockwise direction
 - Signs reminding to Please Keep Routt County Safe
 - Do not enter if sick or at risk
 - Wear facial covering
 - Maintain 6 feet physical distance
 - Sneeze or cough into a tissue or your elbow
 - Please refrain from shaking hands
 - Wash hands often
 - Sign to Please view the Exhibit in Counter-clockwise direction
- As we reopen, we are setting the occupancy limit to 25 to insure easy social distancing. Volunteer or Dottie and other staff members will be monitoring this.
- 6' markers will be placed on the floor for social distancing references.
- Contact tracking sign-in table set 6' out from reception desk for one member of each party with time, name and phone, zip code and if they would like to be on our mailing list.

The front bathroom will be the only bathroom open to public. We will close the back bathroom. Handles will be wiped down hourly and we will spray disinfect surfaces of the bathroom if used. Our cleaning service will commence for regular weekly deep clean. We are meeting with him on Tuesday to discuss cleaning some areas more than once a week.
